Charming Wreath Block



Before you begin sewing: TEST YOUR 1/4" SEAM - Using scraps, cut 3 rectangles 2.5" wide x 6.5" long. Sew together on the long sides. Press & measure. The piece should measure 6.5" square. If it measures wider than 6.5" (sewn width) adjust your seam. *Use a 1/4" seam throughout all steps.

	Green F1	Half Yard
	Dark Pink F2	Fat Quarter
	Pink F3	Fat Quarter
	Peach F4	Fat Quarter
	Yellow F5	Fat Quarter

Cutting Instructions:

4 Yellow 2 1/2" squares

HST's

8 Yellow 3 1/2" squares (make 16 HST's - Trim Down to 2 1/2")

8 Green 3 1/2" squares (make 16 HST's - Trim Down to 2 1/2")

- Make 16 - 2 1/2" HST's - Square up to 2 1/2"

Pinwheels

16 Green 2 1/2" squares - cut in half diagonally once

8 Peach 2 1/2" squares - cut in half diagonally once

8 Dark Pink 2 1/2" squares - cut in half diagonally once

- Make 4 - 2 1/2" Dark Pink Pinwheels - Square up to 2 1/2"
- Make 4 - 2 1/2" Peach Pinwheels - Square up to 2 1/2"

QST's

2 Yellow 4" squares - cut in half diagonally once

1 Green 3 1/4" square - cut in half diagonally twice

1 Dark Pink 3 1/4" square - cut in half diagonally twice

- Make 4 - 2 1/2" Quarter Square Triangles - Square up to 2 1/2"

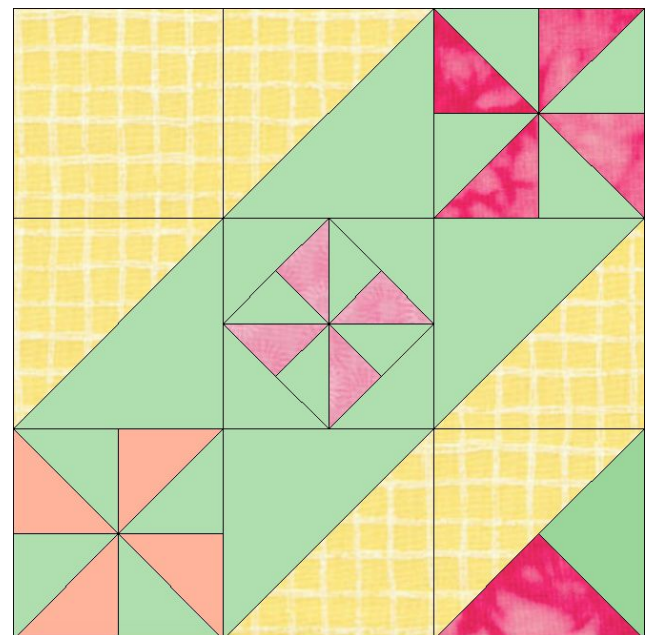
Pinwheel In A Square

4 Green 2 1/2" square - cut in half twice

4 Pink 2 1/2" square - cut in half twice

8 Green 3" squares - cut in half diagonally once

- **Trim inner pinwheels to 1 3/4" before adding out corners**
- Final trim - Square up to 2 1/2"



Make 4 - 6 1/2" blocks - Rotate them and sew together in a four patch to create the one 12 1/2" Block
