



Rain #quiltblockmania

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Fabric Requirements:

- 1 - Fat Quarter - Background
- Various Fat Eighths Blues
- Paper backed fusible (i.e. Heat N Bond Lite)

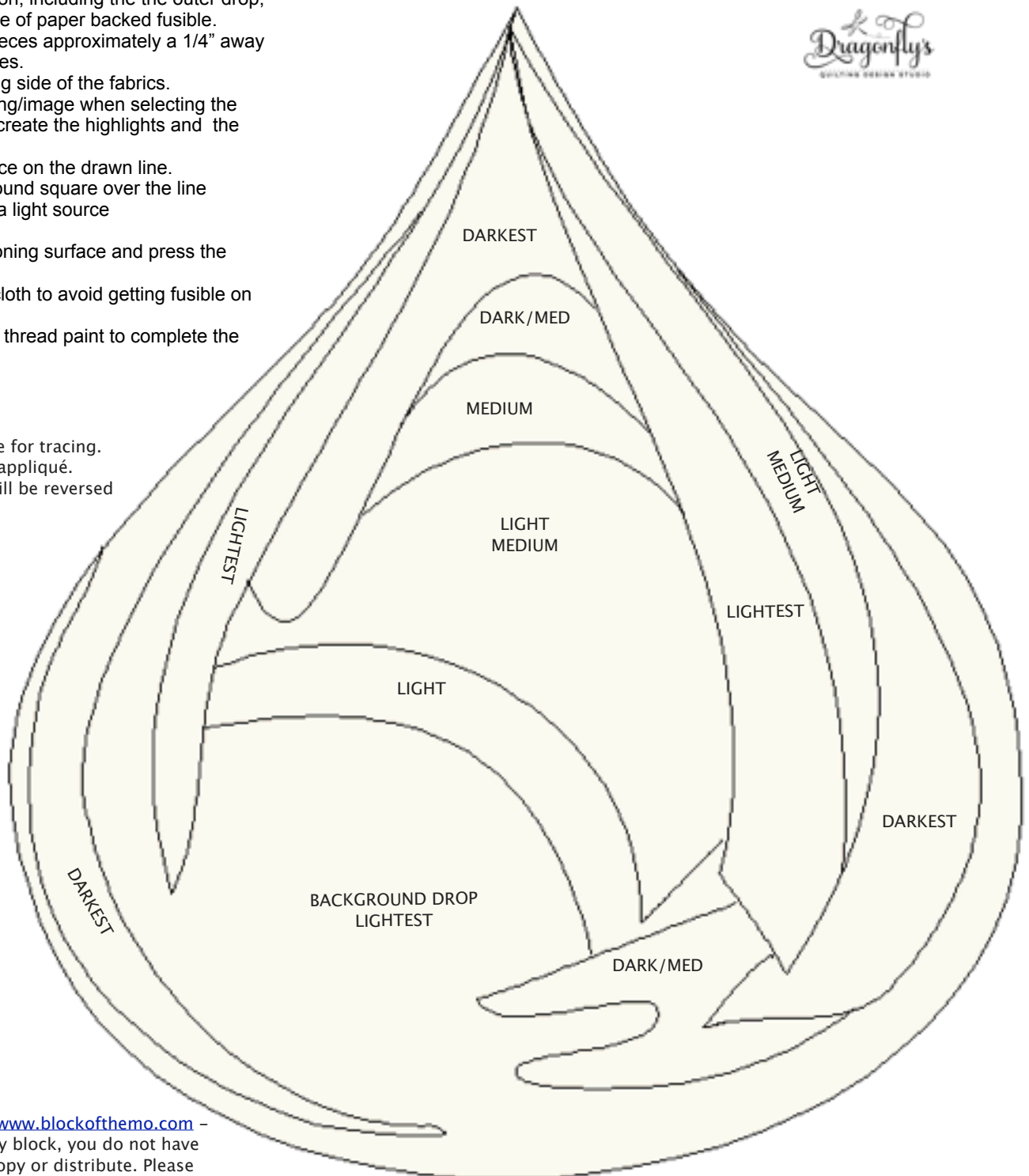
Fat Sixteenth = 9" x 11" ~ *Fat Eighth = 9' x 18" ~ *Fat Quarter = 18" x 22"

Instructions 12" (12.5" unfinished):

- Trace each section, including the the outer drop, onto the paper side of paper backed fusible.
- Rough cut the pieces approximately a 1/4" away from the drawn lines.
- Fuse to the wrong side of the fabrics.
- Follow the coloring/image when selecting the fabric choices, to create the highlights and the raindrop.
- Cut out each piece on the drawn line.
- Lay your background square over the line drawing, on top of a light source
- Place the pieces
- Transfer to an ironing surface and press the pieces in place.
- Use a pressing cloth to avoid getting fusible on the iron.
- Zig zag stitch or thread paint to complete the block.
