Supplies (for one block):

- Fat 1/8 yard of flower fabric
- Scrap for flower center
- 13" square white background fabric
- 1/8 yard of fusible
(Ex. H&B Lite)



Instructions:

Trace the two appliqué flower shapes separately (1 - outer flower & 1 - inner center oval) onto the **paper side** of the fusible
Note: trace all of the inner points (**exemplified as dotted lines in the diagram**) into the center so they can be covered by the oval center.

Trace the outer flower as one large section. Trace the center oval as a second piece. **Trim** the shapes approx. 1/8" away from the traced drawn lines.

Fuse the 2 shapes onto the **wrong side** of the chosen fabrics. **Cut** out the appliqués on the drawn lines. **Fuse** in place onto the **right side** of the 13" background fabric square. When placing the center oval on top of the flower shape, make sure it overlaps the inner points of the flower petals (**exemplified as dotted lines in the diagram**). **Blanket Stitch** to complete. **Square up** block to 12 1/2"

The appliqué will be reversed from this image.

Note: I have tilted the image so it fits on one 8.5" x 11" piece of paper. It might be fun to see them all tilted and turned different ways!
